



She mixed together flour, yeast and water. "Who will help me make the dough?" asked Mother Bear.




She made the bread all by herself. Then Mother Bear asked, "Who will help me bake the bread?


Mother Bear. She put the pan into the oven. Then she waited. And she waited.






After some time, she took the bread out of the oven. "It smells so good," said Mother Bear.
